### WATER FIREWORKS



#### Be sure to ask a grown-up for help!

- What You Need:
  - Water
  - Oil
  - Food Coloring (Any color)
  - 2 16 oz clear glass
  - A Fork

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Fill the tall glass almost to the top with room-temperature water.
- 2. Pour 2 tablespoons of oil into the other glass.
- Add 2 drops of food coloring 3. to the glass with the oil.
- 4. Stir the oil into the food coloring using a fork. Stop once you break the food coloring into smaller drops.
- 5. Pour the oil and coloring mixture into the tall glass.
- Now watch! The food coloring 6. will slowly sink in the glass, with each droplet expanding outwards as it falls. Looks like fireworks! Right?
